Rehearsal and Performance ATTENDANCE

The calendar for the entire season including all rehearsals, performances and competitions is available on the Madison Central Website. <http://www.madisoncentralband.com>

Marching band rehearsals and performances are mandatory. These rehearsals and performances include:

- Rehearsals during band and rookie camp, full days (no leaving early or arriving late)
- Rehearsals during the regular season
- Fall break rehearsals
- Performances

***This will include ALL Saturday competitions, Friday night home football games, pre-season and post season exhibitions/parent performances, indoor shows including performances at elementary schools, middle school, high school, etc. Parades or ANY scheduled public/community performance is included and considered mandatory under this policy.*

The Madison Central Band reserves the right to add or adjust dates as things come up or unforeseen events happen. Whenever possible, the directors/staff will communicate at least 2 weeks notice for these dates. This is not common but does happen from time to time. The attendance policy applies to these dates as well. Simply put, band rehearsals and performances are **mandatory**.

**** Any request for an exception must be submitted online via google forms and approved by the directors one week in advance of the conflicting date****

Work is never an acceptable excuse for missing any band rehearsal or performance event.

Parents, please make every effort to schedule regular doctor, dentist, orthodontist appointments etc. around the band rehearsal and performance schedule.

Students are responsible for arriving at each rehearsal and performance on time with all required materials. On time means at least 15 minutes early. Parents are asked to see that their child take this responsibility seriously because it takes several minutes to get equipment moved and instruments ready for rehearsal.

Excused Absences:

- Death in the immediate family
- Serious personal illness/injury (doctors note required)
- Other issues handled on an individual basis via online requests.

ONLINE GOOGLE FORM REQUEST WILL BE THE ONLY WAY ATTENDANCE ISSUES ARE HANDLED. Text message, email or verbal communication will not be sufficient to consider an absence. The google online request must be submitted for consideration, so that all of the information for the entire program is in the same place and same format.

Unexcused Absences:

- Hair/nail/chiropractor/etc appointments (these must be scheduled around band dates)
- Homework
- Concert/sporting event or any other recreational event
- Birthday
- Work
- Senior pictures
- No ride (let someone know...arrangements can be made)

Attendance

Perfect attendance is the single most important quality of a state champion caliber band. An entire rehearsal can become wasted time if band members are missing. We must function as a team. Our current rehearsal schedule provides students with 1 weekday off and time after school on Thursdays. This allows students and parents to schedule appointments or other activities without causing a conflict with band rehearsals or performances.

Band Camp

2021 Camp dates

- **Rookie Camp** July 12 -14 9am - 4pm (Brand New Members)
- **Visual Camp** July 15 -16 9am - 4pm (ALL MEMBERS)
- **Band Camp Week 1** July 19 - 23 9am - 9pm (ALL MEMBERS)
- **Band Camp Week 2** July 26 - July 30 9am - 9pm (ALL MEMBERS)
- **Preview Show** July 30 7:30 (ALL MEMBERS)

Attendance at the scheduled band camp weeks is mandatory. Please note the camp dates above so that families can avoid conflicts with vacations, trips, appointments, etc.

- Proper clothing is a must. Tennis shoes with arch support must be worn at all times during rehearsal. Flat bottom shoes (vans, etc.) are not acceptable. Please wear cool light colored clothing, sunscreen and sunglasses.
- Bring your own water jug. You must stay hydrated.
- Barring severe weather, we rehearse RAIN OR SHINE. Please have a dry change of clothes and shoes readily available.
- Color Guard information will be distributed by the color guard staff.
- Breakfast before camp is a necessity and you must avoid sodas and sugar filled drinks. Your health should be a top priority and you must take the proper measures necessary to make sure you are capable of fully participating.
- Each member has their own "spot" in the show and it is impossible to learn drill with people missing. That is why it is so important that everyone be at camp EVERY DAY and for the FULL DAY. Each person is important and everyone is counting on you to do your part to make the show and the season a success.
- Students are responsible for providing their own lunch on camp days. Dinner will be provided by the band boosters during Band Camp Week 1 and Band Camp Week 2.

Travel

The Madison Central Band travels state-wide during the competition season. Typically, the band will travel to one overnight destination as well as all other regular competition “day” trips. An itinerary will be available the week of each trip. All school and band rules are in effect for the duration of each trip. You are representing the Madison Central School Community whenever and wherever we perform or travel. We will all do our best to maintain these standards to the highest degree. Our reputation of class, maturity, discipline, and courtesy is known and appreciated state-wide. Take part in this and be proud. The Directors reserve the right to dismiss/send home any student who is in violation of band or school rules or whose general conduct or attitude toward the trip and its participants is proven to be detrimental to the rest of the group.

Competition Procedures

- Pick up itinerary the week of the competition and report promptly at the given itinerary listed call times
- No band member is permitted to leave the organization in advance of group dismissal at any time, unless excused by the director. Students must stay the entire competition day. Parents may check out student from event **ONLY ONCE** throughout the course of the season. Parents must fill out proper paperwork with the director before taking their child.
- While seated in the stands only band members are allowed in the ranks
- During the awards ceremony, the band will stand at attention as a group
- While in the stands, show complete respect for all performing groups
- The band will **STAY TOGETHER AT ALL TIMES** and be dressed uniformly

General Band Rules

- Athletic shoes with arch support must be worn at all marching rehearsals
- Be in attendance block ready to begin **ON TIME**
- Keep the band room and hallway clean and professional
- No jewelry, nail polish, etc. while in uniform
- Keep your language clean. Use self-control. You never know who might be listening.
- Show respect to all directors, administrators, teachers, staff, custodians and parents
- Use of any tobacco products or alcohol during band functions (rehearsals or performance events) will **NOT** be permitted

Band Staff

Paid professionals and technical assistants are a vital part of the band program. Without their help, we would not be able to achieve the standard to which we aspire. They must have the respect and cooperation of all students and parents. Students should give these staff members the same respect they would give any member of the MCHS faculty. Any problems should be brought directly to the directors.

Band Office

The band office is the business office of the marching band and its directors. Students are NOT allowed in the band office without permission of the directors. The telephone in the office is off limits to students except in an emergency. Parents, please make arrangements to pick your child up at the announced dismissal times. We will make every effort to let the ensemble out on time.

Attitude

The total band member is someone who is ALWAYS willing to give their personal best for the good of the group and willing to make sacrifices for something that is much larger than themselves. Being in this Madison Central Marching Band is a tremendous honor, privilege, and opportunity. We take pride in professionalism, hard work and sacrifice. Please have the maturity, presence of mind, self-discipline, and determination needed to make the most of this experience, as it promises to be one that you will never forget.
